Context – CAAP Clean Truck Program Overview

- The Clean Truck Program is an element of the 2017 Clean Air Action Plan (CAAP) Update
 - Goal is to achieve zero emissions truck operations by 2035
 - Supported by various implementation elements, including:
 - Technology Development and Demonstration
 - New Registration Requirements
 - Clean Truck Fund Rate
 - Incentives



Context – Community Impacts

- Historically, low-income, disadvantaged communities are most effected by air pollution
- Comments received that the Ports' air quality policies need to address disproportional impacts in the communities
- Question for discussion:
 - How can the Ports' Clean Truck Programs be structured to address disproportional impacts in the community?



Context – Driver Impacts

- Individual port truck owners/drivers are least well positioned to absorb additional costs
- Comments received that the burden of paying for the Clean Truck Fund Rate should not be forced onto individual truck owners/drivers
